



You will also receive from the Ohio EPA, approximately two months prior to the expiration date, information and instructions concerning renewal of your certificate.

If you wish to alter your registration after initial certification (e.g., add, delete or replace locations), you must request an amended registration form from the Ohio EPA, Division of Solid and Infectious Waste Management at P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1049 or by telephone at (614) 644-2621.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Directors action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney Generals Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed with the Environmental Review Appeals Commission at the following address: Environmental Review Appeals Commission, 309 South Fourth Street, Room 222, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
